Boyko acclaimed for fourth term as chair of Catholic board

SASKATOON, Nov. 8, 2010 – At Monday’s organizational meeting of the Greater Saskatoon Catholic Schools Board of Education, Diane Boyko of Saskatoon was acclaimed as chair of the Board. She begins her fourth one-year term as chair.

Boyko told her colleagues on the Board that she is ready for another exciting year at Greater Saskatoon Catholic Schools. “I think we have done excellent work together. We will continue to strive to achieve our Board’s goals with the incredible staff and administration we are blessed with.”
