Students to elect new Pope

A class of Grade 11 students at St. Joseph High School (**115 Nelson Road; corner of Nelson Road and Attridge Drive**) will hold a conclave to elect a new Pope on **Friday, April 15 from 11:10 a.m.** until approximately **12:10 p.m.**

Students have reviewed eligible candidates from the College of Cardinals and have chosen those they consider to be the top 11 candidates. A two minute presentation on each of the 11 will be made by student delegates with voting to follow. As with the regular conclave at the Vatican, ballots will be burned and a puff of white smoke will announce the election of a new Pope.

Tipi Skylight resource project to be introduced

A new resource for teachers in Saskatoon Catholic Schools is being introduced on **Friday, April 15 at 3 p.m.** at **E.D. Feehan Catholic High School (411 Ave. M North).**

The resource kit includes an instructional PowerPoint on tipi raising and protocol, teaching ideas for Cree language instruction related to the tipi and buffalo hunt as well as posters. Information in the kit also explains how these resources can be used in the classroom and how they fit into the curriculum.

Friday's launch will include singing, drumming and dancing by students from Joe Duquette and an Aboriginal women's group to honour Mary Lee, an Elder at Joe Duquette who was instrumental in the development of this kit, as well as to acknowledge the year of First Nations Women.
