Elementary school students run, jump and throw at annual track and field meet

More than 1,000 elementary students from 35 Catholic schools in Saskatoon will be competing in the annual division track and field meet on **Wednesday, June 1 at Griffiths Stadium. The meet runs from 8:30 a.m. to 4 p.m.** The alternate day in case of inclement weather is Thursday, June 2.

Students age 10 to 14 will be participating in a variety of races as well as jumping and throwing events and school team relays.
